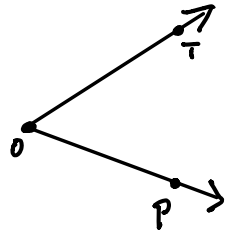


Angles

Two **rays** make up an angle.



Ray OT and Ray OP
make angle TOP or
angle POT.

The symbol for angle = \angle
So, $\angle TOP$ or $\angle POT$.

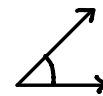
When we **name** angles we use capital letters (just like for our names).

When we give the **types** of angles or **classify** angles, we need to know their measurements in degrees (not temperature).

Types

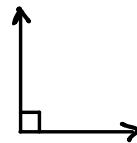
Acute angle

less than 90°



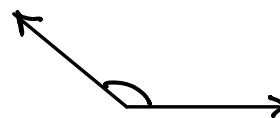
Right/square angle.

90°



Obtuse angle.

more than 90°



Straight angle

180°



Extra information

A circle is 360°

The three interior angles of a triangle add up to 180° .
