## Ratios

A ratio is a comparison between two numbers.

It can be shown in three ways:

1. We say 3 " +0 " 2 .
2. We write $3: 2$.
3. It can also be written as a fraction. $\underline{3}$

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When do we use ratios?
It is a comparison so when a recipe says, "Use flour to water in a $3: 2$ ratio." It is telling you that whatever measuring tool you use ( for example a cup measure), use 3 cups of flour for every 2 cups of water.

We see this used for mixing cement as another example.
